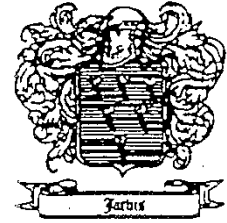


# Jarvis Memorial Scholarship



*This scholarship is designed to benefit youth bowlers in the Spokane County area. It was created by the Jarvis family with the intent to honor both bowling and academic achievement annually. Active supporters of the sport for many decades, the Jarvis family also holds further education in high esteem.*

## Guidelines for Scholarship Applicants

### Qualifications

#### Applicant must be:

1. A graduating high school senior the year the application is made and must have sufficient academic record to be accepted by an accredited college, junior college or vocational school.
2. An active member of an organized bowling league in Spokane County.

#### Selection Criteria:

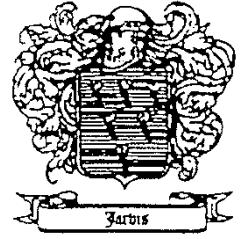
1. Character
2. Scholastic Achievement
3. Bowling Achievement
4. Leadership Potential

# Rules and Regulations

1. Recipient may attend any institution of higher learning of his/her choice.
2. Scholarships awarded shall be applied to tuition and fees.
3. When the scholarship holder has been selected, arrangements shall be made to transfer the scholarship amount to the Jarvis Scholarship Fund SMART account (Account number 13462).
4. When the scholarship holder is enrolled in an accredited institution, they will be able to have these scholarship funds transferred to that institution to apply to their tuition and fees.
5. The funds in the scholarship holder's SMART account will be available to them for eight years after their high school graduation.
6. In the event a scholarship holder has not used all of their scholarship funds at the end of their eight year eligibility, any unused portion will be forfeited and returned to the Jarvis Scholarship Fund.
7. Scholarship information will be sent to bowling proprietors, High Schools and the Spokane County USBC association.
8. The Scholarship Committee shall meet following the close of the application period (March 31, 2019) to review applications and make selection of the recipient(s) prior to April 30, 2019.
9. Notification of scholarship award shall be sent to the recipient, with copies to the local USBC association and other media deemed appropriate by the committee.
10. The scholarship shall be presented by members of the Scholarship Committee.

For the 2018-19 school year, there will be one or more \$2,000 scholarships awarded to a graduating high school senior(s) who are an active member of an organized bowling league in Spokane County.
