## SCUSBC Youth Kickoff Tournament Rules

- 1) This tournament consists of a 9-pin no-tap doubles tournament.
- 2) At least one in three entries in each classification will receive awards. All award fees will be returned 100%. Scholarships will be sent to SMART Account #9827.
- 3) Doubles handicap will be 90% of the difference between the team average and 440 (All fractions will be dropped).
- 4) CLASSIFICATIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:  
**DOUBLES**
  - a. 300 and over
  - b. 299 and under
- 5) Entry fees: \$50 for doubles. (\$13.50 for prize fees, \$10 for bowling and \$1.50 for expenses per bowler per event).
- 6) All Youth bowlers with a current USBC membership number are eligible to enter.
- 7) **Non USBC Youth participants must complete a youth membership application and pay \$10 for a Standard Membership prior to bowling. (This payment will make the youth eligible to bowl in any 2022-23 certified league without paying any additional membership dues.)**
- 8) **Use your highest certified average for the 2021-22 season.** If you do not have a certified 2021-22 average, use your highest certified average from any previous season. If no certified average, bowlers under the age of 14 (on August 1, 2022) will use an assigned average of 120 and those 14 and older will use an assigned average of 159..
- 9) **Any bowler who has only a certified average from a non-standard league will have their average rerated based on the USBC Challenge/Sport Conversion chart.**
- 10) The Tournament Manager has the right to re-rate bowlers prior to bowling. Their entry fees will be returned if the bowler does not accept the re-rated average.
- 11) Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated. Undue displays of temper and the disturbing of other bowlers will not be allowed. Poor conduct or abuse of bowling center equipment may result in disqualification by the Tournament Director.
- 12) All protests or appeals must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager within 72 hours of the date bowled as per USBC Rule 329.
- 13) **All bowlers MUST be checked in at least one-half hour prior to squad times, and averages verified by coaches.**
- 14) Dress attire must be neat, clean and proper fitting. Collared shirts and slacks, walking shorts, capris, or skorts are suggested. **No hats, denim with holes, spandex, leggings, or sweats will be allowed.** Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, gambling, an illegal substance or use inappropriate language/gestures during competition (USBC Rule 301b). Tournament Director must approve any/all exceptions. Tournament Director's decision is final.
- 15) If the tournament, or squads in the tournament, is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the entry fees for bowlers scheduled in the cancelled squad(s) will be refunded.
